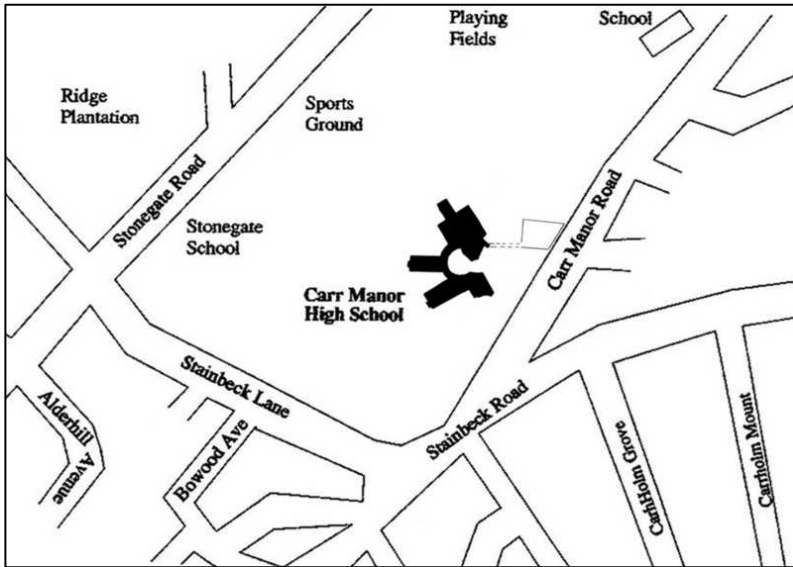

North Leeds Music Centre

We offer group tuition classes for many instruments including clarinet, flute, saxophone, recorder, brass, violin/viola, cello, double bass, guitar, bass guitar, drum kit and keyboard.

We have a number of ensembles including recorders, clarinets, guitars, brass and saxophone as well as training and senior orchestras and a choice of two jazz orchestras - training and senior.

Young children (3 to about 8 years) can join one of our “Mini Music Maker” classes which introduces children to the magic of music and rhythm and then progress on to an instrument, such as recorder or violin, or to a singing group (Find Your Voice).

Our theory classes complement our practical tuition classes. For anyone learning an instrument, or just playing for fun, a knowledge of theory makes music easier to understand, easier to read and play, and more enjoyable to listen to.

NORTH LEEDS MUSIC CENTRE is one of eight Music Centres in Leeds, the others being East Leeds, Guiseley, Horsforth, Rothwell, South Leeds, West Leeds and Wetherby.

Special Features

Starter Theory - At enrolment your teacher will discuss whether you need to take this theory class and, if so, it will form part of your tuition for the first term. There is NO additional fee for this class.

Snack Bar – Our very popular Snack Bar is open during the morning in the Refectory and offers a variety of hot and cold drinks and snacks as well as a convivial atmosphere in which to relax and socialise.

Office and Shop – We have an Office for Music Centre enquiries and enrolment and a Shop selling music books, theory papers, strings and reeds. We normally only stock music books used in our classes. The Office and Shop is located in the Library near the main entrance and opens between 9.30am and noon.

Instrument Hire – Most members buy or rent their own but we do have a number of instruments for hire. Please enquire at enrolment. Alternatively, you may hire an instrument from various Music Shops. For details, enquire at enrolment.

North Leeds Music Centre Fees 2010-2011

All members pay an annual membership (enrolment) fee of £27.
(up to a maximum membership per family of £54)

In addition, a session (class) fee is payable as follows:

½ hour Recorder
or Mini Music Maker class£27.00 per year (children under 7years)

½ hour tuition class£72.90 per year (children and adults)
first year reduced to£60.75 per year (children and adults)

1 hour ensemble or orchestra£62.00 (children under 18 years,
over 60's and students having tuition)

1 hour ensemble or orchestra£94.50 (adults)

Different lengths of classes are calculated pro-rata.

Special Offers – Anyone paying for a tuition class receives $\frac{1}{3}$ off one ensemble fee.

Families are entitled to the cheapest class free for the 4th and subsequent member.

Anyone joining the Senior Orchestra or Jazz Orchestra
can join the Wind Band and/or String Orchestra at a 50% discount.
(North Leeds Music Centre offer only)

Young people joining a City of Leeds Youth Music Group (CLYM)
pay the full Music Centre fee but do not have to pay the CLYM fee.

Payment – All Students must pay the membership fee in full in September and either
make one full payment in September or two instalments
(approximately $\frac{2}{3}$ in September, $\frac{1}{3}$ in January).

Payment can only be made by cash or cheque, we do not accept credit or debit cards.
We DO NOT give discount for Leeds Card.

In cases of financial difficulty, class fees and/or enrolment fees may be reduced.
