

NORTH WEST LEEDS JUNIOR MUSIC CENTRE

The Music Centre will re-open for the Autumn Term on:

in Tinshill Middle School, Woodnook Drive, off Tinshill Lane, Leeds, 16.

The work of the Music Centre is arranged to provide opportunity for young musicians to meet together week by week to participate in Group Tuition in Violin, Viola, Cello, Woodwind and Brass instruments, and Orchestral, Concert Band and Ensemble Playing.

It is hoped that each meeting will be both enjoyable and worthwhile for all who are present. Pupils of any age who are playing any musical instrument are welcome to attend.

We also have a separate Guitar Section, taught in two groups, one for beginners and elementary players, and another for pupils who have already progressed to a more advanced stage.

Interested Recorder players are invited to take part and it is hoped to form a separate Recorder group.

It is advisable that children who come to the Music Centre should already know the basics of musical notation and the elementary technique of their instrument, from their lessons at school or from private music lessons. Complete beginners should wait until they have made some progress on their instrument. Once they are able to play simple 'folk tune' or 'hymn tune' melodies they will find they will be able to participate more happily in our practising.

Concerts are arranged from time to time, so that Parents may have the opportunity to observe the work done by the children.

Girls and Boys who wish to attend should arrive at Tinshill Middle School on Saturday, 10th September at 10 a.m., or any subsequent Saturday morning.
