### **EASTER HOLIDAYS**

First of all, a reminder that next week is the last meeting before Easter. We are closed on 4th, 11th and 18th April. We re-open on 25th April.

### **ACCOMMODATION**

Those of you who were here 2 weeks ago will have experienced the problems we had with the doors locking everyone in (or out). I am awaiting a reply from the Lettings Department about the problems which occurred that day but, hopefully, we won't have a similar problem again. I was informed that all the emergency exits have a green button behind a glass and that hitting this button will release the door if it is locked. Please be aware of this should we ever have this situation again. The red "fire alarm" button is only to be used if there is a fire because hitting that button will automatically call out the fire brigade.

Whilst talking about accommodation, last week we had to get the toilets on the 1st floor of B block closed due to them being in an unacceptable state. This has also been reported to the Lettings Department. For those who don't know, there are other toilets situated on the ground floor of A block (ladies), ground floor B block (gents) and ground floor C block at the far end beyond the hall and drama studio (ladies and gents).

Could I please ask all students and staff to advise me if they find any rooms or facilities not acceptable, including rubbish or rooms not cleaned, windows left open, etc.

### **ABSENCE**

This time of year we always seem to experience a drop in numbers of students attending classes. There are several reasons for this including exams and revision, sports, etc. It is important, however, that you keep your teacher informed if you are going to be away so that classes can be planned accordingly.
